You will learn how to support the elderly and people with disabilities to maintain independence, dignity, and quality of life.

This nationally recognised qualification opens doors to a fulfilling career in Australia's growing health and community care sector.

- Communication and relationship-building skills in a care environment
- Safe and ethical work practices

### Course Structure

he program includes core and elective units focused on both ageing and disability support, delivered through a mix of classroom learning, practical training, and workplace experience.

### Work Placement

To complete this qualification, you will undertake a minimum of 120 hours of supervised work placement in an approved aged care, disability, or community service setting.

## CHC33021 - CERTIFICATE III IN INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT

The CHC43015 Certificate IV in Ageing Support is designed for individuals who want to advance their career in the aged care sector, taking on leadership or specialised care roles. This qualification equips you with the skills and knowledge to provide personalised care, coordinate services, and support the independence and wellbeing of older people in residential, community, or home care settings.

### What You Will Learn

- Supporting clients with complex needs
- Coordinating services and care plans
- Promoting independence, wellbeing, and social inclusion
- Managing legal and ethical responsibilities in aged care

### Course Structure

To achieve the CHC43015 – Certificate IV in Ageing Support, students must complete 15 units of competency, including 10 core units and 5 elective units.

### Work Placement

Students are required to complete 120 hours of supervised work placement in an aged care setting. NDI assists in arranging placements through our network of industry partners.

# CHC43115–CERTIFICATE IV IN DISABILITY

The CHC43115 – Certificate IV in Disability equips you with the skills, knowledge, and practical experience to support people with disabilities to achieve greater independence, enhance their quality of life, and actively participate in their community. Delivered by the National Diversity Institute of Australia, this nationally recognised qualification prepares you for a rewarding career in disability services where you can make a meaningful impact every day.

## Course Structure

To achieve the CHC43115 – Certificate IV in Disability, students must complete 14 units of competency, comprising 11 core units and 3 elective units.

A minimum of 120 hours of practical placement in a registered disability services organisation is required to successfully complete the qualification. This hands-on experience ensures you graduate job-ready and confident.

# CHC52021 – DIPLOMA OF COMMUNITY SERVICES

The CHC52021 – Diploma of Community Services prepares you for leadership and specialist roles in the community services sector. You will learn how to design, deliver, and manage person-centred programs, advocate for individuals and groups, and lead teams to provide effective and sustainable community support. 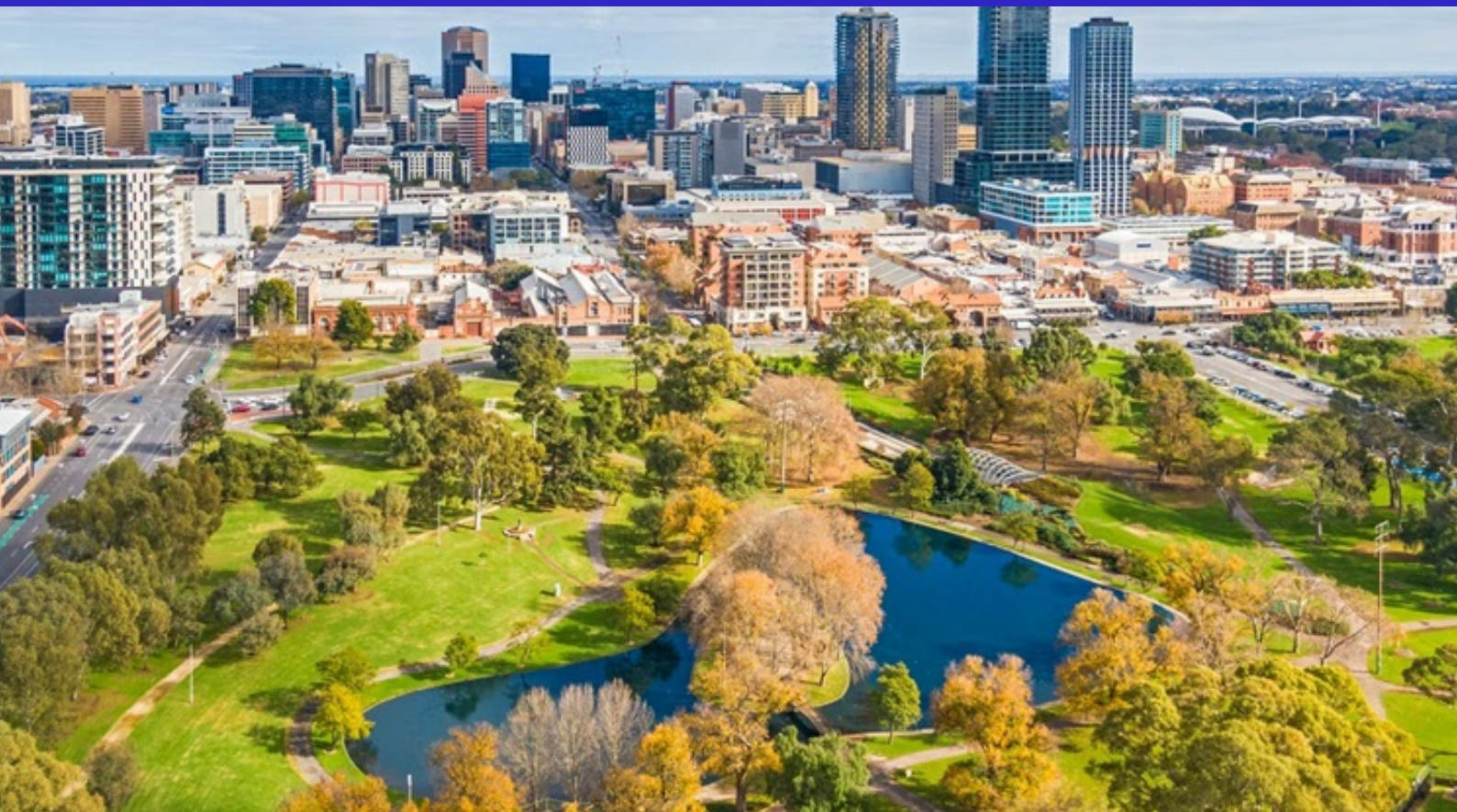
